

Warning:

- Do not clean the units with a pressure washer.

Important information:

- This fitting must be mounted on either a concrete surface or a paving slab that has been concreted in position
- Plan the desired layout of this fitting carefully, ensuring the cables will reach the distance between the junction box and the light fitting.
- Avoid locating any cables in positions that would cause a hazard. Position cables and outdoor rated junction boxes (not supplied) away from areas where they may be at risk from being cut, trapped or damaged.
- Cables must be protected using suitable conduit or plastic trunking.
- When changing a lamp, always switch off at the mains and allow the lamp to cool before handling. Dispose of used lamp carefully. Do not exceed the wattage stated or use a different shape lamp from that indicated on the fitting.

Installation:

Existing fittings must be completely removed before installation of a new product. Before removing the existing fitting, carefully note the position of each set of wires.

- 1) Using the base plate as a template, mark the fixing holes onto the mounting surface.
- 2) Drill holes to the necessary size and depth - taking care not to damage any concealed pipes or wiring below the mounting surface.
- 3) We recommend fitting this product with expanding bolt type fixings which are suitable for use on most surfaces, however alternative fixings may be required.
- 4) Push the fixing bolts into the mounting holes and secure.
