- 2) Drill holes to the necessary size and depth taking care not to damage any concealed pipes or wiring below the mounting surface.
- 3) We recommend fitting this product with expanding bolt type fixings which are suitable for use on most surfaces, however alternative fixings may be required.
- 4) Push the fixing bolts into the mounting holes and secure.
